A Message From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I think it's fair to say that Spring is officially upon us. A nor'easter, an earthquake, and a solar eclipse may have thrown us a weather curve ball last week, but Spring is still coming. The flowers are blooming, trees are waking up, and my allergies are kicking in. As we look forward to Spring I want to bring your attention to two things.

International Night

You will see in this bulletin an advertisement for the Daughters of the Holy Family's 2nd Annual International Night. Those who grew up in Hicksville know that it has radically changed over the years. What was once a monolithic culture has grown into a rich tapestry of take out nationalities. Indeed the whole world wants to move to Hicksville.

International Night is a great way to celebrate the cultural diversity of our parish, meet fellow parishioners, and try foods from around the world.

It is unfortunate that at times it seems like it is the same people coming to parish events. Being Catholic is more than just coming to Sunday Mass. If you've never been to a parish event where we're just coming together to have fun - please come. If you think you're too young, old, etc. you're not coming anyway. This is a great night whether you've been in the parish from day one or if you moved to Hicksville yesterday.

First Holy Communions

It is indeed that time of year when children will make their First Holy Communions. Please pray for these young children as they prepare to meet Jesus in the Eucharist for the first time.

Pray also that they keep their outfits clean for their Communion, the party, Mass the next day, and the May Crowning.

When I see these little ones making their first, second, and consequent Communion, I am always challenged. I ask myself if I have the same amount of love for the Eucharist today that I had when I was in 2nd grade. Certainly, I know more about the Eucharist than I did when I was younger, but I recall being utterly at peace after receiving Jesus at Mass.

Today, it is so tempting to be at Mass and to be thinking of what I need to do next; the meetings I have, the places I need to go, etc. Indeed, how many of us reading this bulletin will leave Mass early for one reason or another?

Today after Mass, I will make sure to say the prayer offered to me on a prayer card at my First Communion:

ANIMA CHRISTI

Soul of Christ, sanctify me. Body of Christ, save me. Blood of Christ, inebriate me. Water from the side of Christ, wash me. Passion of Christ, strengthen me. O good Jesus, hear me. Within Thy wounds hide me. Separated from Thee let me never be. From the enemy, defend me. At the hour of death, call me. And close to Thee bid me. That with Thy saints I may be Praising Thee, forever and ever.

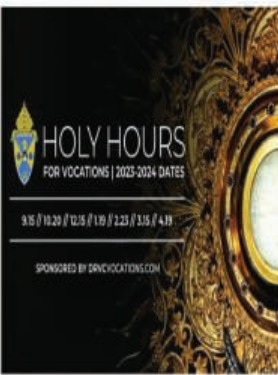

Class Mass

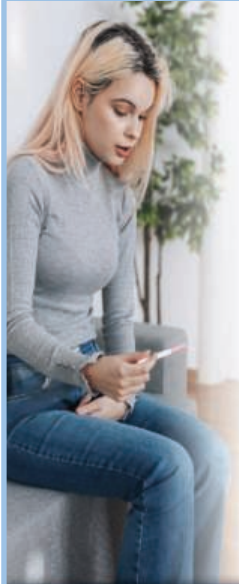

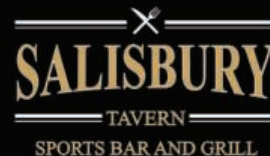

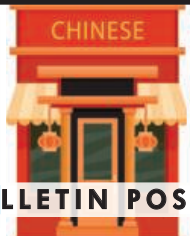
